Duties will include assisting with activities of daily living and providing supportive care in the consumers' home, according to their personal needs and direction.

We are looking to hire a dynamic, energetic, responsible and caring individual that understands and promotes independent living. CSINW is able to offer 20-40 hours a week dependent upon the successful candidates' suitability and availability. Hours will be required throughout the day including morning, afternoon and some evening work, and may include weekend work.

The successful applicant will be required to provide an acceptable criminal records check upon hire as well as obtain first aid & CPR level C. CSINW is willing to fully train the appropriate candidate and the position would start as soon as possible and mutually agreeable.

CSINW provides a competitive pay rate of \$20.23 - \$21.88 plus \$3 wage enhancement while in effect.

CSINW is a consumer driven, community based non-profit charitable organization providing assistance and resources to persons with physical disabilities and seniors.

Applicants will assist persons with physical disabilities in their own homes with activities of daily living such as;

- Assisting with personal care, bowel/bladder care, hygiene, and grooming
